Replacement of cooling coils for chilled water Air Handling Unit (AHU) at Auditorium of the Embassy of India.

Embassy of India, Kuwait invites bids from interested companies by 25th July, 2018 for replacement of old and supply of new cooling coils for chilled water Air Handling Unit (AHU) at Auditorium of the Embassy of India.

2. The scope of the work will be as under:

- (i) Isolation of chilled water inlet & outlet piping.
- (ii) Draining of chilled water
- (iii) Disconnection of chilled water inlet & outlet connections
- (iv) Dismantling of air handling unit panels to remove the cooling coils (2 Nos.)
- (v) Removal of drain piping.
- (vi) Dismantling of cooling coils (2 Nos.)
- (vii) Supply and installation of new chilled water cooling coils (2 Nos.)
- (viii) Re-fixing of drain piping.
- (ix) Re-fixing of air handling unit panels (2 Nos.)
- (x) Reconnecting the chilled water inlet and outlet piping.
- (xi) Testing of the cooling coils for chilled water Air Handling Unit.
- (xii) The quoted price should include charges for labour/transportation etc.

3. The site of work will be open for inspection and discussion, if required, which can be held during office hours with the undersigned upto 23rd July, 2018.

4. Interested companies should have at least 10 years recent experience in similar work having worked with government and/or major organizations in Kuwait. The offer should also include the company profile and experience indicating the organizations where similar work is being done.

5. All offers should be in two sealed covers marked "**Technical Bid**" **To be opened by addressee only** and "**Financial Bid**" – **To be opened by addressee only** and addressed to the "Head of Chancery", Embassy of India, Daeya, Diplomatic Enclave, Arabian Gulf Street, Safat 13015, Kuwait. The offer must be delivered at the Embassy on or before **1200 hrs on 25th July, 2018**.

6. The "Technical Bid" should contain all technical and quality parameters mentioned above. The "Financial Bid" should contain only the quotation for the tender and should be valid for a minimum period of six months.
